

SHC Sports Business Global Course 2026 Application Guideline

Course Overview

Objective

The objective of this course is to develop the ability to view J.League clubs from a global perspective and to understand both the ideal and the actual state of club management through international comparison. In addition, through learning conducted entirely in English, the course aims to enhance participants' ability to engage effectively in global discussion environments.

Course Format (Tentative)

■Course Period : 17 May (Sunday) –5 July (Sunday), 2026

A total of 18 lectures (sessions) over 10 days

※Principally Thursdays from 8:00 PM; with some sessions on Sunday during the day.

■Course Structure : A combination of online and in-person lectures, conducted in English.

– Pre-assignments (provided according to each session)

– Lectures • Theme-based discussions based on the “J.LEAGUE CLUB MANAGEMENT GUIDE 2025”

• Individual assignments and presentations

• Sharing of insights on global sports business by guest lecturers

– Post-assignments (reflection etc.)

■Number of Participants : 3 Approximately 30 participants

■Venue : Online; Zoom In-person; Lecture venue ※ Some sessions will be held in Tokyo in a hybrid (online & in-person) format.

■Completion Requirements : Attendance of at least 70% of all sessions and submission of assignments, in principle

Target Participants

Individuals who have an interest in the management of professional sports clubs from diverse backgrounds—such as the J.League, J.League clubs, general corporations, and overseas leagues and clubs—and who are motivated to learn together across national and league boundaries from a global perspective.
